

UACJ Logistics Corporation Becomes Subsidiary, to Further Expand the Cargo Transportation Business

SENKO Co., Ltd. (Head office: Osaka-shi; President: Yasuhisa Fukuda; "SENKO") has acquired 66.7% of stocks of UACJ Logistics Corporation (Head office: Nagoya City, President: Hiroyuki Fukui, "UACJ Logistics"), which operates cargo transportation and other businesses and is a group company of leading global aluminum manufacturer UACJ Corporation (Head office: Tokyo, President: Miyuki Ishihara, "UACJ"), and plans to make it a subsidiary in December this year. SENKO and UACJ concluded a share transfer agreement dated August 28.

UACJ Logistics operates eight sales offices in Japan and transports a wide range of materials including aluminum-related and refined copper products.

It also has approximately 100 vehicles, covering a wide range of sizes from small and large to tractor units, and a servicing yard is located adjacent to the head office as part of a system that ensures the company's own fleet is maintained safely.

By making UACJ Logistics a subsidiary, SENKO will aim to expand business and improve productivity by coordinating with cargo transportation specialist Senko A Line Amano, as well as secure and enhance transportation capability of the SENKO Group and increase trade with the UACJ Group. UACJ Logistics will be able to harness the many resources and know-how that SENKO has available, to further develop its own business.
